





Reordering Elements by Hand




Don't nest deeply - return early

```
bool Order::Calculate(double x, double y)
```

```
{  
    if (x < limit)  
    {  
        if (y >= 0)  
        {  
            if (shipping)  
            {  
                //... actual calculation setting some member variable  
                return true;  
            }  
            else  
            {  
                error = Errors::NotShipping;  
                return false;  
            }  
        }  
        else  
        {  
            error = Errors::YNegative;  
            return false;  
        }  
    }  
    else  
    {  
        error = Errors::XTooLarge;  
        return false;  
    }  
}
```

Could The Language Help Us?

- Should we add keywords or attributes? Would you use them?
 - implicit
 - const(false)
 - nonvirtual
 - ByVal
- Are you using fallthrough and maybe_unused?
 - Why not?
